To enhance public property and encourage an aesthetically pleasing environment, the Terrell Parks Department established a tree and bench donation program. This program enables citizens to have a tree planted or a park bench installed and maintained by the City of Terrell within public right-of-ways, parks, or other city-controlled areas to celebrate a special occasion such as a wedding anniversary, birthday, or memorial for friends and family members.

Memorial Tree:

A memorial tree can be a living remembrance of a loved one or a celebration of a happy event. This is a unique way to enhance the beauty and quality of our parks and city for many years. Donors may choose from the list provided.

For a Donation of **\$600**, the City will plant a tree from the Master Tree List. The City will provide a commemorative certificate with the GPS coordinates of the location of your tree.

Master Tree list:

Southern Magnolia, Autumn Blaze Red Maple Tree, Tulip Poplar, Chinese Pistache
Southern Red Oak, Live Oak Tree, Oklahoma Redbud, Yaupon Holly Tree

The list is based on native species, long-term maintenance, degree of hardiness, growth rate, and other considerations.

Memorial Bench:

Memorial benches provide a way to honor or remember a loved one while offering a place of rest for park visitors to help them enjoy nature and their surroundings.

The cost to purchase a memorial bench with a plaque is **\$3,400**. *Money for the benches will be donated to the City of Terrell in the person or group's name. The City or its designee, will purchase the bench along with a brass plaque affixed to the bench. Benches will be secured to a concrete slab. These items become the property of the City of Terrell. The City will install and oversee the installation and upkeep of the bench.

**Terms and Conditions for application approval:**

- The sponsor/donor must meet with the Parks Department to receive approval for the tree/bench location. Location requests are considered, but not all can be accommodated due to existing park events/ programming and layout. Factors such as vehicular and pedestrian traffic, underground and above-ground utilities, property lines, water availability, and other aspects shall be considered.
- All trees will be purchased, installed, and maintained by City Staff. This includes the original planting, replacement if necessary, pruning, pest and fungus control, removal, storm damage repairs, staking, etc.
- The seasonal planting of new or replacement trees shall occur from Fall through Spring weather permitting.
- To maintain the beautification and uniformity of our parks, no benches or additional accessories should be added next to the tree or bench.

All accessories added will be removed and discarded.
